

REVEREND WILLIAM JOHN TERENCE OAKLEY

Reverend William Oakley was the vicar of Tansor, Cotterstock and Fotheringhay from 1956 to 1974.

He was ordained by the Bishop of Wakefield in 1932 and served in Yorkshire until the outbreak of WW2 when he became a chaplain to the Forces. He was awarded the Military Medal for "Acts of gallantry and devotion to duty" in 1941.

After the war he was vicar of Cloughfold from 1948 – 1952 and then the vicar of East Kirkby with Minningby and Hagnaby until 1956 when he moved to Northamptonshire. He retired on the 31st August 1974 and his retirement was announced in the local newspaper.
